

God's

in  
Creation

God Created the Universe  
For His Glory  
and  
For our Glory

For His Glory

Be exalted, O God, above the heavens;  
*Let Your **glory** be above all the earth.* (Psalm 57:11)

Declare His **glory** among the nations,  
His wonders among all peoples. (Psalm 96:3)

And one cried to another and said:  
“Holy, holy, holy *is* the LORD of hosts;  
The whole earth *is* full of His **glory!**” (Isaiah 6:3)

For the earth will be filled  
With the knowledge of the **glory** of the LORD,  
As the waters cover the sea. (Habakkuk 2:14)

For our Glory



And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (John 14:13)

By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. (John 15:8)

And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.

(John 17:10)

OT – Hebrew word “kabod”, meaning heaviness or weight or worthiness. Used of men to describe their wealth, splendor, reputation, or honor. The most important concept is that of the glory of Yahweh. Denotes the revelation of God’s being, nature, and presence to mankind, sometimes with physical phenomena.

(Exodus 24:17)

The glory of Yahweh displayed in supernatural plagues that delivered Hebrews from slavery in Egypt.

The glory of Yahweh in the cloud that led the Hebrews out of Egypt and in the wilderness.

(Exodus 16:7,10)

The glory of Yahweh filled the tabernacle.

(Exodus 40:34-35)

Vision of Ezekiel (1:28)

Messianic Prophecies (Isaiah 40:4-5, 60:1-3)

NT – “kabod” generally translated “doxa”. Describes the revelation of the character and presence of God in the Person and work of Jesus Christ. He is the outshining of the divine glory. (Hebrews 1:3)

Was seen by the shepherds (Luke 2:9-14)

Transfiguration (Mark 9:2-8)

Crucifixion (John 12:23)

Resurrection and ascension (Luke 24:26, Acts 3:13)

Man made in the image and glory of God for relationship with Him. (1 Corinthians 11:7)

## Romans 8:18-25

<sup>18</sup>For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy  
*to be compared* with the glory which shall be revealed in us. <sup>19</sup>  
For  
the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the  
revealing  
of the sons of God. <sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility,  
not  
willingly, but because of Him who subjected *it* in hope; <sup>21</sup>  
because  
the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of  
corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. <sup>22</sup> For  
we  
know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs  
together until now. <sup>23</sup> Not only *that*, but we also who have the  
firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves,

to announce good news  
 (“evangelize”)  
 especially the gospel



The Gospel is  
“the power of God to salvation.”

Romans 1:16

Specifically, God created a world full of sin and suffering in order to save a people and bring them to glory. This is the purpose of evangelism.

Romans 8:19-20; 28-30
